Updated Versioning System

The versioning system for both the Study and Dataset levels has been updated to a 2-digit system, reflecting best practices for indicating major and minor changes. Data depositors and data curators can specify whether an update to a Study or a Dataset is "Major" or "Minor".

- Major changes increment the first digit of the version number (e.g., 1.0 → 2.0), indicating significant modifications.
- Minor changes increment the second digit (e.g., $1.0 \rightarrow 1.1$), reflecting smaller updates.

For datasets, minor updates retain the existing DOI to maintain continuity and ease of access. Major updates require a new DOI to ensure clear and accurate tracking of data alterations. Studies do not use DOIs and are unaffected by this change.

Enhanced Version Control for Data Curators

With the updated Versioning system, data curators are able to **switch between** "Major" and "Minor" changes for a Study or Dataset before publication, if they believe the depositor's initial choice might be incorrect. This change ensures adherence to the SWISSUbase Versioning policy.

Search Engine Optimisation Enhancements

Improvements have been made to the **search engine optimisation**. These changes increase findability and machine-actionability of the dataset metadata.
