1. The data depositor, {{RESEARCHER}}, {{INSTITUTION}}, either as data owner or as representative,

a) maintains the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) to the data referred to in point 2 as well as to the corresponding documentation,

c) confirms that the data have been anonymized, or that the necessary informed consent has been obtained,

2. Data to be archived

Data and documentation from the project titled {{STUDY_TITLE}}, under the direction of {{RESEARCHER_PI}}.

3. Data archiving objectives

The deposit of the data and documentation at SWISSUbase has the following objectives:

a) their archiving at SWISSUbase,

b) their reuse by third parties as defined by the applied licenses or closed user contracts.

4. Responsibilities of SWISSUbase

SWISSUbase agrees to

a) archive the data and the documentation in accordance with its possibilities and technical standards,

b) make the data and documentation available to third parties as defined by the applied licenses or closed user contracts,

c) inform data users of their contractual and legal obligations, which in particular consist in

- respecting the defined licenses or closed user contracts for data reuse,

- respecting the Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP) of 19 June 1992, if they use personal data or sensitive data.

SWISSUbase is, however, not responsible for possible violations of these terms by data users.

5. Rights of SWISSUbase

- a) SWISSUbase has the right to publish information on the data and the corresponding research project in order to inform about the archived data and to promote their reuse,
- b) SWISSUbase has the right to provide copies of the archived data and the corresponding documentation to third parties as defined by the applied licenses or closed user contracts,
- c) SWISSUbase has the right to analyze archived data for the purpose of generating statistics (e.g. number of downloads).
